Any court order for the custody of, or visitation with, a child [may] shall include a provision 4 that the sheriff or other law enforcement officer shall 5 enforce the rights of any person to custody or visitation 6 7 unless the court issues a subsequent order pursuant to 8 chapter 210, 211, 452 or 455 to limit or deny the custody 9 of, or visitations with, the child. Such sheriff or law enforcement officer shall not remove a child from a person 10 who has actual physical custody of the child unless such 11 12 sheriff or officer is shown a court order or judgment which 13 clearly and convincingly verifies that such person is not entitled to the actual physical custody of the child, and 14 15 there are not other exigent circumstances that would give 16 the sheriff or officer reasonable suspicion to believe that the child would be harmed or that the court order presented 17 to the sheriff or officer may not be valid."; and 18 19 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
