\$ 314.7M HIGHER EDUCATION CAPITAL PROJECTS

The General Assembly authorized 27 capital improvement projects. We have designed these projects to address emergency needs, infrastructure development and program enhancements.

\$ 8M OPERATION LONE STAR BORDER SUPPORT

I supported the governor's decision to send 200 national guardsmen to secure the border crisis in Texas. This includes 22 Missouri Highway Patrol troopers to assist current operations led by Texas Highway Patrol.

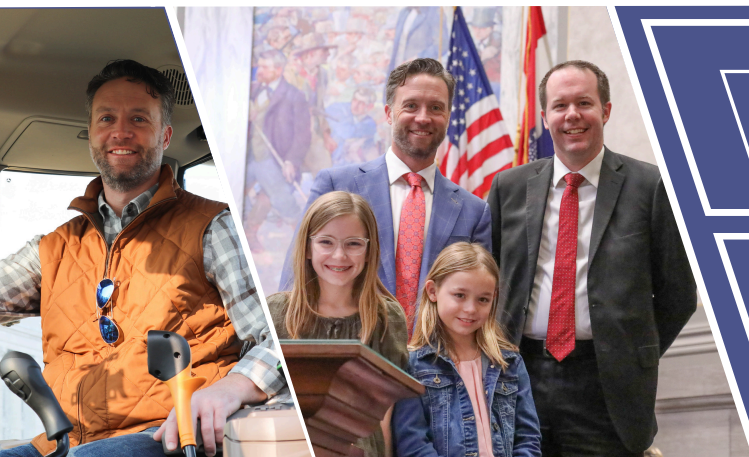
\$ 14.2M OPIOID PREVENTION AND RECOVERY EXPANSION

I prioritized and ensured the continued development of our public safety and security programs. Included in these investments was the Opioid Prevention, Treatment and Recovery Expansion program, providing more services to those in desperate need.



\$ 290M INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENT

One of my most important objectives is developing our infrastructure around the state. Last year, I led the General Assembly in investing billions into expanding and rehabilitating I-70. Now, we are investing millions into alternative roadways across the state.

I've secured record-breaking funding for MoExcels projects to facilitate the development of employer-driven workforce education programs. These programs provide training for high-demand occupations and prepare the next generation to be Show-Me Missourians.
