The attorney general may appeal any preliminary 14 15 injunction that existed prior to August 28, 2025, under subsection 2 of this section. 16 Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to 17 ensure judicial efficiency, the repeal and reenactment of 18 section 526.010 of section A of this act is deemed necessary 19 20 for the immediate preservation of the public health, 21 welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an 22 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and 23 the repeal and reenactment of section 526.010 of section A 24 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and 25 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly. 26
