Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 22, Page 1, Section Title, Line 4,

2 by striking the words "ballot summaries" and inserting in
3 lieu thereof the following: "judicial proceedings"; and

4 Further amend said bill, page 6, section 116.190, line
5 132 by inserting after all of said line the following:

6 "526.010. 1. Injunctions may be granted by a circuit
7 judge[,] or an associate circuit judge.

8 2. In any action in which the state or a statewide
9 official is preliminarily enjoined from implementing,
10 enforcing, or otherwise effectuating any provision of the
11 Constitution of Missouri, any Missouri statute, or any
12 Missouri regulation, the attorney general may appeal the
13 preliminary injunction.

14 3. The attorney general may appeal any preliminary
15 injunction that existed prior to August 28, 2025, under
16 subsection 2 of this section.

17 Section B. Because immediate action is necessary to
18 ensure judicial efficiency, the repeal and reenactment of
19 section 526.010 of section A of this act is deemed necessary
20 for the immediate preservation of the public health,
21 welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an
22 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and
23 the repeal and reenactment of section 526.010 of section A
24 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its
25 passage and approval."; and

26 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
