Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 43, Page 42, Section 477.715, Line 15,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "537.046. 1. As used in this section, the following  
4 terms mean:

5 (1) "Childhood sexual abuse", any act committed by the  
6 defendant against the plaintiff which act occurred when the  
7 plaintiff was under the age of eighteen years and which act  
8 would have been a violation of section 566.030, [566.040,  
9 566.050] 566.031, 566.032, 566.034, 566.060, [566.070,  
10 566.080, 566.090] 566.061, 566.062, 566.064, 566.067,  
11 566.068, 566.069, 566.071, 566.083, 566.086, 566.093,  
12 566.095, 566.100, [566.110, or 566.120] 566.101, 566.209,  
13 566.210, 566.211, or [section] 568.020;

14 (2) "Injury" or "illness", either a physical injury or  
15 illness or a psychological injury or illness. A  
16 psychological injury or illness need not be accompanied by  
17 physical injury or illness.

18 2. Any action to recover damages from injury or  
19 illness caused by childhood sexual abuse in an action  
20 brought pursuant to this section shall be commenced within  
21 ten years of the plaintiff attaining the age of twenty-one  
22 or within three years of the date the plaintiff discovers,  
23 or reasonably should have discovered, that the injury or  
24 illness was caused by childhood sexual abuse, whichever  
25 later occurs.

26           3. This section shall apply to any action commenced on  
27 or after August 28, ~~2004~~ 2025, including any action which  
28 would have been barred by the application of the statute of  
29 limitation applicable prior to that date.

30           4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the  
31 contrary, a nondisclosure agreement by any party to a  
32 childhood sexual abuse action shall not be judicially  
33 enforceable in a dispute involving childhood sexual abuse  
34 allegations or claims, and shall be void."; and

35           Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
