Amend SS/Senate Bill No. 43, Page 13, Section 210.145, Line 127,

2 by inserting after "shall" the following: "verbally
3 identify himself or herself and his or her role in the
4 investigation and shall"; and further amend line 148, by
5 inserting after "9." the following: "In all cases in which
6 a case worker is investigating an instance of alleged child
7 abuse or neglect and visiting the home or location where the
8 abused child is located or where any child who may have been
9 witness to another child's abuse is located, the case worker
10 shall first verbally identify himself or herself and his or
11 her role in the investigation and shall inform the child's
12 parent or guardian that neither the child nor parent or
13 guardian is required to speak with the case worker, allow
14 the case worker to enter the home, or otherwise provide the
15 case worker with access to the child, without a warrant or
16 court order and that the parent or guardian has the right to
17 contact an attorney.
18 10."; and further amend by renumbering the remaining
19 subsections accordingly.
