- 2 by inserting after all of said line the following:
- 3 "68.080. 1. There is hereby established in the state
- 4 treasury the "Waterways and Ports Trust Fund". The fund
- 5 shall consist of revenues appropriated to it by the general
- 6 assembly.
- 7 2. The fund may also receive any gifts, contributions,
- 8 grants, or bequests received from federal, private, or other
- 9 sources.
- 10 3. The fund shall be a revolving trust fund exempt
- 11 from the provisions of section 33.080 relating to the
- 12 transfer of unexpended balances by the state treasurer to
- 13 the general revenue fund of the state. All interest earned
- 14 upon the balance in the fund shall be deposited to the
- 15 credit of the fund.
- 4. Moneys in the fund shall be withdrawn only at the
- 17 request of a Missouri port authority for statutorily
- 18 permitted port purposes and upon appropriation by the
- 19 general assembly, to be administered by the state highways
- 20 and transportation commission and the department of
- 21 transportation, in consultation with Missouri public ports,
- 22 for the purposes in subsection 2 of section 68.035 and for
- 23 no other purpose. To be eligible to receive an
- 24 appropriation from the fund, a project shall be:
- 25 (1) A capital improvement project implementing
- 26 physical improvements designed to improve commerce or

- 27 terminal and transportation facilities on or adjacent to the
- 28 navigable rivers of this state;
- 29 (2) Located on land owned or held in long-term lease
- 30 by a Missouri port authority, or on land owned by a city not
- 31 within a county and managed by a Missouri port authority, or
- 32 within a navigable river adjacent to such land, and within
- 33 the boundaries of a port authority;
- 34 (3) Funded by alternate sources so that moneys from
- 35 the fund comprise no more than eighty percent of the cost of
- 36 the project;
- 37 (4) Selected and approved by the highways and
- 38 transportation commission, in consultation with Missouri
- 39 public ports, to support a statewide plan for waterborne
- 40 commerce, in accordance with subdivision (1) of section
- 41 68.065; and
- 42 (5) Capable of completion within two years of approval
- 43 by the highways and transportation commission.
- 44 5. Appropriations made from the fund established in
- 45 this section may be used as a local share in applying for
- 46 other grant programs.
- 47 6. The provisions of this section shall terminate on
- 48 August 28, 2033, pending the discharge of all warrants. On
- 49 December 31, 2033, the fund shall be dissolved and the
- 50 unencumbered balance shall be transferred to the general
- 51 revenue fund."; and
