governmental interest is compelling only if it is for the

limited purpose and has the limited effect of improving or

Notwithstanding subsection 4 of this section, the 26 general assembly may enact laws that regulate the provision 27 of abortion after fetal viability provided that under no 28 circumstance shall the government deny, interfere with, 29 30 delay, or otherwise restrict an abortion that in the good faith judgment of a treating health care professional is 31 32 needed to protect the life or physical or mental health of 33 the pregnant person.
- 6. No person shall be penalized, prosecuted, or 34 35 otherwise subjected to adverse action based on their actual, potential, perceived, or alleged pregnancy outcomes, 36 including but not limited to miscarriage, stillbirth, or 37 abortion. Nor shall any person assisting a person in 38 exercising their right to reproductive freedom with that 39 40 person's consent be penalized, prosecuted, or otherwise 41 subjected to adverse action for doing so.
 - 7. The government shall not discriminate against persons providing or obtaining reproductive health care or assisting another person in doing so.
