by inserting after all of said line the following: 2 "568.045. 1. A person commits the offense of 3 endangering the welfare of a child in the first degree if he 4 or she: 5

(1) Knowingly acts in a manner that creates a 6 7 substantial risk to the life, body, or health of a child less than seventeen years of age; or 8

9 (2) Knowingly engages in sexual conduct with a person under the age of [seventeen] eighteen years over whom the 10 person is a parent, guardian, or otherwise charged with the 11 12 care and custody;

(3) Knowingly encourages, aids or causes a child less 13 than seventeen years of age to engage in any conduct which 14 15 violates the provisions of chapter 571 or 579;

(4) In the presence of a child less than seventeen 16 years of age or in a residence where a child less than 17 seventeen years of age resides, unlawfully manufactures or 18 19 attempts to manufacture compounds, possesses, produces, prepares, sells, transports, tests or analyzes amphetamine 20 or methamphetamine or any of its analogues. 21

The offense of endangering the welfare of a child 2. 23 in the first degree is a class D felony unless the offense:

(1) Is committed as part of an act or series of acts 24 25 performed by two or more persons as part of an established or prescribed pattern of activity, or where physical injury 26

27 to the child results, or the offense is a second or 28 subsequent offense under this section, in which case the 29 offense is a class C felony;

30 (2) Results in serious physical injury to the child,31 in which case the offense is a class B felony; or
