AN ACT

To amend chapter 9, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to Kappa Alpha Psi Week in Missouri.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 9, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto 2 one new section, to be known as section 9.409, to read as 3 follows:

9.409. 1. The week in which January five falls each
year shall be known and designated as "Kappa Alpha Psi Week"
in Missouri. The citizens of this state are encouraged to
observe the day with appropriate activities and events to
commemorate the founding of the fraternity.

6 2. Kappa Alpha Psi was founded on January 5, 1911, at

9 Peter Blakemore, Ezra Dee Alexander, John Milton Lee, Henry

11 and Paul Waymond Caine.

3. Founding member Henry Tourner Asher was an educator
and instructor at Lincoln Institute, now known as Lincoln
University of Missouri, in Jefferson City.

4. Kappa Alpha Psi is the second oldest existing collegiate historically Black Greek-letter fraternity and the first intercollegiate fraternity incorporated as a national body. The fraternity has over two hundred fifty thousand members with seven hundred undergraduate and alumni chapters in nearly every state of the United States, and **SB 110**

thirteen international chapters in Nigeria, South Africa,
Bermuda, Bahamas, U.S. Virgin Islands, Panama, United
Kingdom, Germany, South Korea, Dominican Republic, Abu
Dhabi, Canada, and Japan.

Through its worldwide prominence, Kappa Alpha Psi 25 5. 26 has had a global impact on events that affect our local 27 communities and places around the globe. Local chapters of 28 Kappa Alpha Psi participate in community outreach activities 29 to feed the homeless, provide scholarships to young people 30 matriculating to college, serve as mentors to young men, participate in blood drives, and serve as hosts of seminars 31 for public health awareness, to name a few. 32 Nationally, 33 Kappa Alpha Psi has provided summer enrichment camps and funds for St. Jude Medical Research Center to assist in the 34 fight against childhood catastrophic diseases by raising 35 36 more than one million dollars. Internationally, Kappa Alpha 37 Psi members have answered the call to service by proudly 38 serving our military in wars since WWI and raising funds to 39 assist those in need following natural disasters worldwide, 40 including hurricanes, tornadoes, typhoons, and earthquakes.
