## AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school meals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 167.204, to read as follows:

167.204. 1. This section shall be known and may be2 cited as the "Missouri School Meals Act".

As used in this section, the term "school" shall 3 2. 4 mean any public school district, public school, public 5 charter school, or private, religious, or parochial school 6 that participates in the National School Lunch Program 7 administered by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), or such program's successor, but that does not 8 9 participate in the Community Eligibility Provision 10 administered by the USDA, or such provision's successor.

11 3. A school shall provide a free lunch to each student who has been approved to receive a reduced price lunch under 12 the National School Lunch Program or its successor program. 13 14 Subject to appropriation, the state board of education shall reimburse schools the difference between the total cost of 15 each lunch provided under this subsection and the federal 16 17 reimbursement rate for each lunch provided under this 18 subsection.

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4. A school shall determine which students may be
eligible for free or reduced price lunch through the
National School Lunch Program or its successor program and
shall provide information and assistance to parents and
guardians of such students for purposes of filling out an
application.

5. A school shall not publicly identify or otherwise
stigmatize a student who is or may be eligible for free or
reduced price lunch. A student's application for the
National School Lunch Program or its successor program shall
be used only for federal reimbursement and for state aid
calculations under chapter 163.

31 6. (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury 32 the "School Meals Fund", which shall consist of moneys 33 appropriated by the general assembly for the purposes of 34 implementing the provisions of this section. The state 35 treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may 36 37 approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and money in the fund shall be used solely by the state 38 39 board of education for the purposes of reimbursing schools as provided in subsection 3 of this section. 40

(2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080
to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end
of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the
general revenue fund.

(3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be credited to the fund.

The state board of education shall promulgate rules
 and regulations for the implementation of this section.

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Such rules shall include the process by which schools may 51 apply for reimbursement as provided in subsection 3 of this 52 section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is 53 defined in section 536.010, that is created under the 54 authority delegated in this section shall become effective 55 56 only if it complies with and is subject to all of the 57 provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 58 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and 59 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective 60 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently 61 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking 62 authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 63 2025, shall be invalid and void. 64

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
