AN ACT

To repeal sections 302.025 and 304.015, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to the use of passing lanes, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

- Section A. Sections 302.025 and 304.015, RSMo, are
- 2 repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be
- 3 known as sections 227.294, 302.025, and 304.015, to read as
- 4 follows:
 - 227.294. 1. The department of transportation shall
- 2 erect and maintain along the highways of this state signs
- 3 that are clearly visible from the highway and which state
- 4 substantially the following message: "Warning: Minimum
- 5 \$100/\$500 fine for improper use of a passing lane".
- 6 2. Locations for the signs shall include freeway
- 7 primary highways, as defined in section 226.510, and other
- 8 major highways, with specific locations to be determined by
- 9 the department of transportation.
 - 302.025. 1. All driver training programs offered
- 2 within this state shall include instruction concerning law
- 3 enforcement procedures for traffic stops, including a
- 4 demonstration of the proper actions to be taken during a
- 5 traffic stop and appropriate interactions with law
- 6 enforcement. Such programs shall also present enrollees
- 7 with the information provided by the department of revenue
- 8 pursuant to section 302.176.

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- All driver training programs offered within this 9 state shall include instruction concerning the use of 10 passing lanes as specified in subsection 6 of section 11 304.015.
- 3. As used in this section, "driver training programs" 13 shall include private drivers' education programs and driver 14 15 training programs taught by an instructor holding a valid 16 driver education endorsement on a teaching certificate issued by the state department of elementary and secondary 17 18 education.
- 1. All vehicles not in motion shall be 304.015. 2 placed with their right side as near the right-hand side of 3 the highway as practicable, except on streets of municipalities where vehicles are obliged to move in one 4 5 direction only or parking of motor vehicles is regulated by 6 ordinance.
- 7 Upon all public roads or highways of sufficient width a vehicle shall be driven upon the right half of the 8 9 roadway, except as follows:
 - When overtaking and passing another vehicle proceeding in the same direction pursuant to the rules governing such movement;
- When placing a vehicle in position for and when 13 14 such vehicle is lawfully making a left turn in compliance with the provisions of sections 304.014 to 304.025 or 15 16 traffic regulations thereunder or of municipalities;
- 17 When the right half of a roadway is closed to traffic while under construction or repair; 18
- 19 Upon a roadway designated by local ordinance as a one-way street and marked or signed for one-way traffic. 20
- 3. It is unlawful to drive any vehicle upon any 21 highway or road which has been divided into two or more 22

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- 23 roadways by means of a physical barrier or by means of a
- 24 dividing section or delineated by curbs, lines or other
- 25 markings on the roadway, except to the right of such barrier
- or dividing section, or to make any left turn or
- 27 semicircular or U-turn on any such divided highway, except
- 28 at an intersection or interchange or at any signed location
- 29 designated by the state highways and transportation
- 30 commission or the department of transportation. The
- 31 provisions of this subsection shall not apply to emergency
- 32 vehicles, law enforcement vehicles or to vehicles owned by
- 33 the commission or the department.
- 4. The authorities in charge of any highway or the
- 35 state highway patrol may erect signs temporarily designating
- 36 lanes to be used by traffic moving in a particular
- 37 direction, regardless of the center line of the highway, and
- 38 all members of the Missouri highway patrol and other peace
- 39 officers may direct traffic in conformance with such signs.
- 40 When authorized signs have been erected designating off-
- 41 center traffic lanes, no person shall disobey the
- 42 instructions given by such signs.
- 43 5. Whenever any roadway has been divided into three or
- 44 more clearly marked lanes for traffic, the following rules
- 45 in addition to all others consistent herewith shall apply:
- 46 (1) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practicable
- 47 entirely within a single lane and shall not be moved from
- 48 such lane until the driver has first ascertained that such
- 49 movement can be made with safety;
- 50 (2) Upon a roadway which is divided into three lanes a
- 51 vehicle shall not be driven in the center lane, except when
- 52 overtaking and passing another vehicle where the roadway
- 53 ahead is clearly visible and such center lane is clear of
- 54 traffic within a safe distance, or in preparation for a left

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turn or where such center lane is at the time allocated
exclusively to traffic moving in the direction the vehicle
is proceeding and is sign-posted to give notice of such
allocation:

- (3) Upon all highways any vehicle proceeding at less than the normal speed of traffic thereon shall be driven in the right-hand lane for traffic or as close as practicable to the right-hand edge or curb, except as otherwise provided in sections 304.014 to 304.025;
- (4) Official signs may be erected by the highways and transportation commission or the highway patrol may place temporary signs directing slow-moving traffic to use a designated lane or allocating specified lanes to traffic moving in the same direction and drivers of vehicles shall obey the directions of every such sign;
- (5) Drivers of vehicles proceeding in opposite directions shall pass each other to the right, and except when a roadway has been divided into traffic lanes, each driver shall give to the other at least one-half of the main traveled portion of the roadway whenever possible.
- 6. All vehicles in motion upon a highway having two or more lanes of traffic proceeding in the same direction shall be driven in the right-hand lane except when overtaking and passing another vehicle or when preparing to make a proper left turn or when otherwise directed by traffic markings, signs or signals.
 - (1) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the operator of a vehicle in violation of this section shall be issued a written warning for a first alleged violation of this subsection in order to inform the operator of the requirements of this subsection. Warnings issued under this subsection shall be included in the

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driver's record accessible by the Missouri uniform law 87 88 enforcement system (MULES). Operation of a motor vehicle in 89 violation of this subsection after receiving a written warning shall be punished by a fine of at least one hundred 90 dollars in addition to other penalties that may be specified 91 92 by law. Subsequent violations of this subsection shall be punished by a fine of at least five hundred dollars in 93 94 addition to other penalties that may be specified by law.

- (2) The Missouri state highway patrol shall specifically instruct members of the patrol with regard to this subsection, and shall enforce the provisions of this subsection to reduce the incidence of motor vehicles operating in the passing lane while not passing or overtaking another vehicle.
- 7. All trucks registered for a gross weight of more than forty-eight thousand pounds shall not be driven in the far left-hand lane upon all interstate highways, freeways, or expressways within urbanized areas of the state having three or more lanes of traffic proceeding in the same direction. This restriction shall not apply when:
- 107 (1) It is necessary for the operator of the truck to
 108 follow traffic control devices that direct use of a lane
 109 other than the right lane; or
- 110 (2) The right half of a roadway is closed to traffic 111 while under construction or repair.
- 112 8. As used in subsection 7 of this section, "truck"

 113 means any vehicle, machine, tractor, trailer, or

 114 semitrailer, or any combination thereof, propelled or drawn

 115 by mechanical power and designed for or used in the

 116 transportation of property upon the highways. The term

 117 "truck" also includes a commercial motor vehicle as defined

 118 in section 301.010.

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9. Violation of this section shall be deemed a class C misdemeanor unless such violation causes an immediate threat of an accident, in which case such violation shall be deemed a class B misdemeanor, or unless an accident results from such violation, in which case such violation shall be deemed a class A misdemeanor.

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
