AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to school meals.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 167.202, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 167.202. 1. This section shall be known and may be
- 2 cited as the "Missouri Free School Meals Program".
- 3 2. As used in this section, the term "school" shall
- 4 mean any school district, public school, charter school, or
- 5 private, religious, or parochial school.
- 6 3. Each school that participates in the United States
- 7 Department of Agriculture National School Lunch Program and
- 8 has an identified student percentage below the federal
- 9 percentage determined for all meals to be reimbursed at the
- 10 free rate through the United States Department of
- 11 Agriculture Community Eligibility Provision shall
- 12 participate in the Missouri free school meals program.
- 4. Each school that participates in the United States
- 14 Department of Agriculture National School Lunch Program and
- 15 has an identified student percentage at or above the federal
- 16 percentage determined for all meals to be reimbursed at the
- 17 free rate through the United States Department of
- 18 Agriculture Community Eligibility Provision shall

participate in the Community Eligibility Provision in order to participate in the Missouri free school meals program.

- 5. Each school that participates in the Missouri free school meals program shall:
- 23 (1) Participate in the United States Department of
 24 Agriculture School Breakfast Program and the United States
 25 Department of Agriculture National School Lunch Program; and
- 26 (2) Provide to all students at no cost up to two
 27 federally reimbursable meals per school day, with a maximum
 28 of one free breakfast and one free lunch.
- 29 The department of elementary and secondary 30 education shall provide to every school participating in the 31 Missouri free school meals program state funding for each 32 school lunch and breakfast served to a student, with a 33 maximum of one breakfast and one lunch per student per 34 school day. The amount of state aid per meal shall be equal 35 to the difference between the applicable federal reimbursement rate at that school site for a free meal, as 36 37 determined annually by the United States Department of Agriculture, and the actual federal reimbursement received 38 39 by the participating school for the breakfast or lunch served to the student. 40
- 41 The department of elementary and secondary 42 education shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions 43 of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under 44 the authority delegated in this section shall become 45 effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of 46 the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 47 48 This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and 49 if any of the powers vested with the general assembly 50 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective

- 52 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking
- authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28,
- 54 2025, shall be invalid and void.
