AN ACT

To repeal section 478.690, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to associate circuit judges in the twenty-fourth judicial circuit.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 478.690, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 478.690,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 478.690. 1. There shall be two circuit judges in the
- 2 twenty-fourth judicial circuit consisting of the counties of
- 3 Madison, St. Francois, Ste. Genevieve and Washington. These
- 4 judges shall sit in divisions numbered one and two.
- 5 2. The circuit judges in divisions one and two shall
- 6 be elected in 1982.
- 7 3. There shall be one additional associate circuit
- 8 judge in St. Francois County. The associate circuit judge
- 9 shall be appointed by the governor and shall serve until
- January 1, 2027, and until his or her successor is duly
- 11 elected in 2026. This associate circuit judge shall not be
- 12 included in the statutory formula for authorizing additional
- 13 associate circuit judges per county as provided in section
- 14 **478.320.**
