## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 321, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to taxes for emergency services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 321, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 321.905, to read as
- 3 follows:
  - 321.905. 1. For the purposes of this section, the
- 2 term "political subdivision" shall mean:
- 3 (1) Any municipality located within a county with more
- 4 than one million inhabitants;
- 5 (2) Any county with more than four hundred thousand
- 6 but fewer than five hundred thousand inhabitants;
- 7 (3) Any county with more than two hundred thirty
- 8 thousand but fewer than two hundred sixty thousand
- 9 inhabitants;
- 10 (4) Any county with more than one hundred thousand but
- 11 fewer than one hundred twenty thousand inhabitants and with
- 12 a county seat with more than four thousand but fewer than
- 13 six thousand inhabitants; and
- 14 (5) Any county with more than two hundred sixty
- 15 thousand but fewer than three hundred thousand inhabitants.
- 16 2. The governing body of a political subdivision may,
- 17 by a majority vote of its governing body, levy and collect
- 18 ad valorem taxes on all real property located within the

If a majority of the votes cast on the proposal by the 34 qualified voters voting thereon are in favor of the 35 proposal, then the ordinance or order and any amendments 36 37 thereto shall be in effect. If a majority of the votes cast by the qualified voters voting are opposed to the proposal, 38 then the governing body of the political subdivision shall 39 40 have no power to impose the property tax as herein authorized unless and until the governing body of the 41 42 political subdivision shall again have submitted another 43 proposal to authorize the governing body to impose the 44 property tax.

3. The governing body of any fire protection district imposing a property tax pursuant to this chapter, of any ambulance district imposing a property tax pursuant to chapter 190, or of any political subdivision imposing a property tax pursuant to subsection 1 of this section, may,

- The total property tax levy subject to reduction 87 88 pursuant to this section shall not include those taxes 89 levied to retire indebtedness.
- 90 Each year in which a sales tax is imposed pursuant to this section, the ambulance district, fire protection district, or political subdivision shall, after determining 92 93 its budget for the provision of ambulance or fire protection 94 services within the limits set by the constitution and laws of this state for the following calendar year and the total property tax levy needed to raise the revenues required by 97 such budget, reduce the total property tax levy imposed pursuant to this chapter or chapter 190, as applicable, in an amount sufficient to decrease the total property taxes it 100 will collect by an amount equal to fifty percent of the sales tax revenue collected pursuant to this section in the tax year for which the property taxes are being levied. 102 103 the event that in the immediately preceding year the 104 ambulance district, fire protection district, or the political subdivision actually collected more or less sales tax revenue, the ambulance district, fire protection district, or the political subdivision shall adjust its 107 108 total property tax levy for the current year to reflect such 109 increase or decrease.

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
