AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to student attendance at scheduled elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

	Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2	one new section, to be known as section 167.1001, to read as
3	follows:
	167.1001. 1. For purposes of this section, the
2	following terms mean:
3	(1) "Election", any primary, general, or special
4	election held to nominate or elect an individual to public
5	office, to retain or recall an elected officeholder, or to
6	submit a ballot measure to the voters;
7	(2) "Parent", a student's parent, legal guardian, or
8	person standing in loco parentis to the student;
9	(3) "School", any school that is funded in whole or in
10	part by state funds, including, but not limited to, a public
11	school or charter school.
12	2. A student shall not be considered absent from the
13	school in which the student is enrolled for the time during
14	which the student accompanies his or her parent when the
15	parent is exercising his or her right to vote in a scheduled
16	election.

3. A student may receive an excused absence pursuant
to subsection 2 of this section only one time during each
scheduled election.

4. A student who accompanies his or her parent when the parent is exercising his or her right to vote in a scheduled election shall be encouraged by school officials to demonstrate his or her attendance at the scheduled election by wearing an official sticker, badge, or other item upon his or her return to school indicating that he or she attended the scheduled election.
