AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to covenants not to compete for physicians.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 191.260, to read as
- 3 follows:
 - 191.260. 1. As used in this section, the term
- "covenant not to compete" means an agreement or part of a
- 3 contract of employment in which the employee agrees to
- 4 refrain from competition with an employer for a specific
- 5 period of time or within a particular geographic area, or
- 6 both.
- 7 2. A covenant not to compete between a physician and
- 8 an employer shall only be enforceable if:
- 9 (1) The physician is providing health care services in
- 10 a clinical setting; and
- 11 (2) The employer is not a health care entity owned or
- 12 operated by a nonprofit corporation that is exempt from
- 13 federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
- 14 Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.
- A valid covenant not to compete between a physician
- 16 and an employer shall:
- 17 (1) Be for a period of no longer than three hundred
- 18 sixty-five days; and

19 (2) Not extend further than fifty miles from the 20 physician's office address.
