AN ACT

To repeal section 251.034, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to state funds for regional planning commissions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 251.034, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 251.034, to read as follows:

251.034. Payments made under sections 251.032 to 2 251.038 to the various regional planning commissions shall 3 be distributed on a matching basis of one-half state funds for one-half of local funds. No local unit shall receive 4 any payment without providing the matching funds required. 5 6 The state funds so allocated shall not exceed the sum of 7 [sixty-five] one hundred thirty thousand dollars for the East-West Gateway Coordinating Council and for the Mid-8 9 America Regional Council. The remaining allocated state 10 funds shall not exceed the sum of [twenty-five] fifty thousand dollars for each of the following regional planning 11 12 commissions: South Central Ozark, Ozark Foothills, Green Hills, [Show-Me,] Bootheel, [Missouri Valley, Ozark 13 Gateway,] Mark Twain, [ABCD,] Southeast Missouri, Boonslick, 14 Northwest Missouri, Mid-Missouri, Kaysinger Basin, Lake of 15 16 the Ozarks, Meramec, Northeast Missouri, Harry S Truman, MO-17 Kan, Pioneer Trails, and [Lakes Country] Southwest 18 Beginning July 1, 2026, and each year after, the Missouri.
