AN ACT

To repeal section 196.935, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the sale of raw milk or cream.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 196.935, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 196.935,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 196.935. No person shall sell, offer for sale, expose
- 2 for sale, transport, or deliver any graded fluid milk or
- 3 graded fluid milk products in this state unless the milk or
- 4 milk products are graded and produced, transported,
- 5 processed, manufactured, distributed, labeled and sold under
- 6 state milk inspection and the same has also been produced or
- 7 pasteurized as required by a regulation authorized by
- 8 section 196.939 and under proper permits issued thereunder.
- 9 Only pasteurized graded fluid milk and fluid milk products
- 10 as defined in subdivision (3) of section 196.931 shall be
- 11 sold to the final consumer, or to restaurants, soda
- 12 fountains, grocery stores, or similar establishments; except
- 13 that:
- 14 (1) An individual may purchase [and have delivered to
- 15 him for his own use] raw milk or cream directly from [a
- 16 farm] the milk producer;
- 17 (2) An individual may purchase raw milk or cream from
- 18 the milk producer at a farmer's market, as such term is

defined in section 144.527, provided that the raw milk or cream is clearly labeled as such; or

(3) An individual may purchase raw milk or cream from the milk producer, either in person or through an internet sale, and arrange to pick up the milk or cream from a grocery store, restaurant, soda fountain, or similar establishment. The milk producer may enter into an agreement with such establishment for the onsite storage of the purchased milk or cream for purchaser pickup; provided that the establishment shall not engage in the sale of raw milk or cream to consumers. The establishment may charge a reasonable fee to the milk producer for the storage of the milk or cream. The stored raw milk or cream shall be clearly labeled as such and separated from other milk or cream products stored by the establishment.
