## **AN ACT**

To repeal section 441.043, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to local government ordinances for rental property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 441.043, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 441.043,
- 3 to read as follows:
  - 441.043. 1. No county or city, or county or city with
- 2 a charter form of government may enact, maintain, or enforce
- 3 any ordinance or resolution which regulates the amount of
- 4 rent to be charged for privately-owned, single-family, or
- 5 multiple-unit residential or commercial rental property.
- 6 2. No county or city, or county or city with a charter
- 7 form of government, shall enact, maintain, or enforce any
- 8 ordinance or resolution that:
- 9 (1) Prohibits landlords from refusing to lease or rent
- 10 a privately owned, single-family, or multiple-unit
- 11 residential or commercial rental property to a person
- 12 because the person's lawful source of income to pay rent
- includes funding from a federal housing assistance program;
- 14 (2) Prohibits landlords from using income-qualifying
- 15 methods, credit scores, credit reports, eviction or property
- damage history, or prohibits landlords from requesting such
- 17 information, to determine whether to rent or lease a
- 18 property to a prospective tenant;

- 21 (4) Limits the amount of security deposit a landlord 22 may require from a prospective tenant; or
- 23 (5) Requires tenants to automatically receive the 24 right of first refusal.
- 25 3. This section shall not be construed as prohibiting 26 any county or city, or any authority created by a county or 27 city for that purpose, from:
- 28 (1) Regulating in any way property belonging to that 29 city, county, or authority;
- 30 (2) Entering into agreements with private persons
  31 which regulate the amount of rent charged for subsidized
  32 rental properties; or
- (3) Enacting ordinances or resolutions restrictingrent for properties assisted with community developmentblock grant funds.
