## AN ACT

To repeal section 8.016, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to security of the state capitol.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 8.016, RSMo, is repealed and one new  
2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 8.016,  
3 to read as follows:

8.016. 1. The commissioner of the office of  
2 administration shall provide each member of the senate and  
3 each member of the house of representatives with a key that  
4 accesses the dome of the state capitol.

5 2. **The commissioner of the office of administration**  
6 **shall provide each member of the senate and each member of**  
7 **the house of representatives with a key or key card that**  
8 **accesses the state capitol. Upon written request by a**  
9 **member of the senate or house of representatives, the**  
10 **commissioner of administration shall also provide the**  
11 **member's spouse or children with a key or key card that**  
12 **accesses the state capitol.**

13 3. The president pro tem of the senate and the speaker  
14 of the house of representatives shall be responsible for  
15 providing a training program for the members and staff of  
16 the general assembly regarding access to secured areas of  
17 the capitol building. They may consult with the office of

18 administration and department of public safety when  
19 developing such program.
