AN ACT

To repeal section 33.290, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to appropriation allotments made to state departments.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 33.290, RSMo, is repealed and one new

- 2 section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 33.290,
- 3 to read as follows:
 - 33.290. 1. Within two weeks after the approval of the
- 2 appropriation acts by the governor, each department shall
- 3 submit to the budget director a work program and requested
- 4 allotments of appropriations by quarterly periods for the
- 5 first fiscal year of the biennium. Such requested
- 6 allotments shall show how the department proposes to
- 7 classify its expenditures for various purposes and objects
- 8 of expenditure within each such quarterly period for the
- 9 fiscal year. Such allotment requests and the allotments as
- 10 approved shall be in such form and in such detail as the
- 11 budget director shall direct. Such allotments shall be
- 12 subject to approval by the governor in such detail as he may
- 13 determine except that the allotments of the departments not
- 14 directly under the control of the governor shall be subject
- 15 to approval only as to the total allotment for each
- 16 quarter. At the end of any quarterly period any department
- 17 may make changes in the allotments for the remaining periods
- 18 upon approval of the governor. At the end of any quarterly

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19 period the governor may revise the allotments of any 20 department, and if it shall appear that revenues in any fund 21 for the fiscal year will fall below the estimated revenues for such fund to such extent that the total revenues of such 22 23 fund will be less than the appropriations from such fund, 24 then and in such case, the governor shall reduce the 25 allotments of appropriations from such fund to any 26 department or departments so that the total of the 27 allotments for the fiscal year will not exceed the total 28 estimated revenue of the fund at any such time. Each such 29 department shall in its requested allotments set aside three percent of the appropriations as a reserve fund which shall 30 31 be subject to expenditure only with approval of the governor; provided, that this shall not apply to amounts for 32 personal service to pay salaries fixed by law. On or before 33 34 June first of the first fiscal year of the biennium, similar work programs and requested allotments of the appropriation 35 for the second fiscal year of the biennium shall be 36 37 submitted to the budget director. Such requests and 38 allotments shall be subject to the same approval, 39 limitations and changes as those for the first year. 40 At the end of each quarterly period, each 41

At the end of each quarterly period, each department shall submit to the budget director the number of permanent full-time positions which have been vacant for ninety days or more in such form and in such detail as the budget director shall direct, and the governor shall reduce the total of the allotments for the fiscal year to the department in order to account for the vacant positions.

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
