INTRODUCED BY SENATOR GREGORY (15).

AN ACT

To amend chapter 577, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to illegal aliens, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 577, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 577.678. 1. As used in this section, the following
- 2 terms mean:
- 3 (1) "Certified bounty hunter", a person who:
- 4 (a) Possesses a valid unexpired license as a bail bond
- 5 agent, general bail bond agent, or surety recovery agent
- 6 under sections 374.695 to 374.789; and
- 7 (b) Is certified under this section to find and detain
- 8 illegal aliens in this state;
- 9 (2) "Department", the department of public safety;
- 10 (3) "Illegal alien", a person who is not lawfully
- 11 present in the United States as defined and described under
- 12 8 U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq., as amended;
- 13 (4) "Life imprisonment", imprisonment for the duration
- 14 of a person's natural life;
- 15 (5) "Peace officer", as defined in section 590.010.
- 16 2. (1) A person commits the offense of trespass by an
- 17 illegal alien if such person:
- 18 (a) Is an illegal alien;
- (b) Knowingly enters this state and remains in this
- 20 state; and

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- 21 (c) Is physically present in this state at the time a 22 licensed bounty hunter or a peace officer apprehends such 23 person.
- (2) (a) The offense of trespass by an illegal alien under this section is a felony for which the authorized term of imprisonment is life imprisonment without eligibility for probation, parole, conditional release, or release except by act of the governor or the natural death of such person.
- 29 (b) The provisions of this section shall not apply if 30 the federal government enters into a written agreement with 31 the department to take such person into custody and, within 32 twenty-four hours of such person being committed to the 33 custody of the federal government, deport such person.
- 3. A person who commits the offense of trespass by an illegal alien shall be forever disqualified from:
- 36 (1) Registering and voting in any election under the 37 laws of this state;
- 38 (2) Securing any certificate or registration or 39 authority, permit, or license to drive under the laws of 40 this state;
- 41 (3) Applying for or receiving any state or local 42 public benefit offered by this state or a political 43 subdivision of this state; and
- 44 (4) Becoming a legal resident of this state.
- 4. Each person who is apprehended under this section shall provide a DNA sample under the same procedures for collecting a DNA sample described in sections 650.050 to 650.100.
- 49 5. Subject to appropriations:
- 50 (1) (a) The department shall develop and maintain an 51 information system that operates at all times and provides

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various means to receive and maintain reports of violations of subsection 2 of this section;

- 54 (b) The various means of receiving such reports shall
- include, but not be limited to, a toll-free telephone
- 56 hotline, email address, and online reporting portal. The
- 57 department shall periodically publicize the hotline
- telephone number, email address, internet website address,
- and any other means by which the department may receive such
- 60 reports;
- 61 (c) A person who makes a report under this section may
- 62 choose to remain anonymous until the person affirmatively
- 63 consents to having the person's identity disclosed;
- 64 (d) The information system shall be staffed by off-
- 65 duty peace officers, retired peace officers, and any other
- 66 peace officer deemed qualified by the department to staff
- 67 the information system; and
- 68 (e) If an illegal alien is arrested and imprisoned
- 69 under this section as a result of a report to the
- 70 information system, the person who made the report shall be
- 71 eligible to receive a reward of one thousand dollars for
- 72 providing such report; and
- 73 (2) (a) The department shall develop and implement
- 74 the "Missouri Illegal Alien Certified Bounty Hunter
- 75 Program", which is hereby created to certify applicants to
- 76 the program as certified bounty hunters for purposes of
- 77 finding and detaining illegal aliens in this state under
- 78 this section;
- 79 (b) The program shall be administered by the
- 80 department under the following application and certification
- 81 procedures:
- 82 a. A person who possesses a valid unexpired license as
- 83 a bail bond agent, general bail bond agent, or surety

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84 recovery agent under sections 374.695 to 374.789 may apply

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- 85 to the department to be certified as a licensed bounty
- 86 hunter;
- b. The department shall accept applications filed in
- 88 the manner established by rule and on a form prescribed by
- 89 the department. A completed application shall contain:
- 90 (i) The date the application was prepared;
- 91 (ii) The applicant's signature;
- 92 (iii) A copy of the person's valid unexpired license
- 93 as a bail bond agent, general bail bond agent, or surety
- 94 recovery agent under sections 374.695 to 374.789;
- 95 (iv) A mailing address where the applicant can be
- 96 contacted by the department for purposes of receiving first
- 97 class mail, legal documents, and certified mail;
- 98 (v) A telephone number or numbers where the applicant
- 99 can be called by the department; and
- 100 (vi) Other information deemed necessary by the
- 101 department; and
- 102 (c) Upon receipt of a completed application, the
- department may certify the applicant as a licensed bounty
- 104 hunter. The term of certification shall be for four years
- 105 following the date of initial certification unless the
- 106 applicant withdraws the certification or the department
- 107 cancels the certification before such date. The department
- 108 shall notify each licensed bounty hunter of the
- 109 certification's expiration and provide a renewal form to
- 110 such licensed bounty hunter at least four weeks before such
- 111 expiration.
- 112 6. (1) There is hereby created in the state treasury
- 113 the "Missouri Illegal Alien Certified Bounty Hunter Program
- 114 Fund", which shall consist of moneys appropriated by the
- 115 general assembly. The state treasurer shall be custodian of

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- the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180,
- 117 the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund
- shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, moneys in
- this fund shall be used solely to provide moneys to the
- 120 department for the implementation and administration of this
- 121 section.
- 122 (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080
- 123 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end
- of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the
- 125 general revenue fund.
- 126 (3) The state treasurer shall invest moneys in the
- 127 fund in the same manner as other funds are invested. Any
- 128 interest and moneys earned on such investments shall be
- 129 credited to the fund.
- 7. The Missouri attorney general and the prosecuting
- 131 attorney or circuit attorney of each county shall prosecute
- 132 charges filed under this section.
- 8. The department may promulgate all necessary rules
- and regulations for the administration of this section. Any
- 135 rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in
- 136 section 536.010, that is created under the authority
- 137 delegated in this section shall become effective only if it
- 138 complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of
- 139 chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This
- 140 section and chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the
- 141 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter
- 142 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove
- 143 and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional,
- 144 then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed
- or adopted after August 28, 2025, shall be invalid and void.
