AN ACT

To amend chapter 160, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to panic alert technology in schools.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 160, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 160.072, to read as follows:

160.072. Beginning with the 2026-2027 school year, 2 each school district and charter school shall provide each 3 staff person, including at least one such person in each 4 classroom, with mobile panic alert technology that allows 5 for immediate contact and two-way communication with 6 emergency services or emergency services agencies, law 7 enforcement agencies, fire departments, and school 8 administration. Prior to the first day of each school year, 9 each school district and charter school shall ensure that 10 all school facility personnel receive training on the 11 protocol for and appropriate use of such mobile panic alert 12 technology.
