AN ACT

To amend chapter 188, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to health care.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 188, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto
2 one new section, to be known as section 188.034, to read as
3 follows:

188.034. 1. Except in the case of a medical
2 emergency, no person shall knowingly perform, induce, or
3 attempt to perform or induce an abortion on another using
4 mifepristone, or knowingly provide the means for another
5 person to undergo an abortion by using mifepristone, without
6 also providing a legible, written notice to the person
7 considering the abortion that is approved by the department
8 of health and senior services and that reads substantially
9 as follows:

10 NOTICE TO PERSONS HAVING DRUG-INDUCED OR
11 CHEMICAL ABORTIONS THAT USE MIFEPRISTONE:
12 Mifepristone (also known as Mifeprex and by
13 other names) used alone will not always induce
14 an abortion. It may be possible to reverse its
15 intended effect so that your unborn child can be
16 born alive if the second pill or tablet has not
17 been taken or administered. If you change your
18 mind and want to try to keep your baby, you can
19 get immediate help by accessing available

resources, including through
www.abortionpillreversal.com, or you can contact
(877) 558-0333 for assistance in locating a
medical professional who can aid in the reversal
of an abortion.

2. The department of health and senior services shall
cause to be published in state-prepared printed material and
on a state-prepared and state-maintained website the
following statement on informed consent for abortion:

Information on the ability of qualified medical
professionals to potentially reverse the effects
of an abortion obtained through the use of
abortion-inducing drugs or chemicals is
available at www.abortionpillreversal.com, or
you can contact (877) 558-0333 for assistance in
locating a medical professional who can aid in
the reversal of an abortion.

3. The department of elementary and secondary
education and the department of higher education and
workforce development, working with the department of health
and senior services, shall develop a public awareness sign
that is consistent with subsection 2 of this section and
that shall be displayed in every restroom in secondary
schools and institutions of higher education in this state.
The required public awareness sign shall be at least 8.5
inches by 11 inches in size, be printed in at least 16-point
font, and shall be in both English and Spanish.

4. On an annual basis, the department of elementary
and secondary education and the department of higher
education and workforce development, working with the
department of health and senior services, shall review and,

51 if necessary, update the information required under
52 subsection 3 of this section.

53 5. Hospital emergency rooms shall display a public
54 awareness sign developed by the department of health and
55 senior services that is consistent with subsection 2 of this
56 section in waiting areas and patient facilities. The
57 required public awareness sign shall be at least 8.5 inches
58 by 11 inches in size, be printed in at least 16-point font,
59 and state substantially the following in English and Spanish:

60 Information on the ability of qualified medical
61 professionals to potentially reverse the effects
62 of an abortion obtained through the use of
63 abortion-inducing drugs or chemicals is
64 available at www.abortionpillreversal.com, or
65 you can contact (877) 558-0333 for assistance in

68 6. On an annual basis, the department of health and
69 senior services shall review and, if necessary, update the
70 information required under subsections 1, 2, and 7 of this
71 section.

72 7. The department of health and senior services shall
73 direct all hospital emergency rooms to display a sign in
74 waiting areas and patient facilities that is at least 8.5
75 inches by 11 inches in size, is printed in at least 16-point
76 font, and states substantially the following in English and
77 Spanish:

78 If you have had an abortion, including if you
79 have taken abortion pills obtained online,
80 please tell your health care provider so that
81 your medical treatment can be as effective as
82 possible.

83 8. The department of health and senior services may
84 promulgate all necessary rules and regulations for the
85 administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a
86 rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is
87 created under the authority delegated in this section shall
88 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to
89 all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable,
90 section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are
91 nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the
92 general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay
93 the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are
94 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of
95 rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
96 August 28, 2025, shall be invalid and void.

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
