JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri, an amendment repealing sections 50 and 51 of article III of the Constitution of Missouri, and adopting two new sections in lieu thereof relating to initiative petitions.

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next following the first Monday in November, 2026, or at a special election to be called by the governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for adoption or rejection, the following amendment to article III of the Constitution of the state of Missouri:

Section A. Sections 50 and 51, article III, Constitution of Missouri, are repealed and two new sections adopted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 50 and 51, to read as follows:

Section 50. Initiative petitions proposing amendments 2 to the constitution shall be signed by [eight] fifteen 3 percent of the legal voters in each of [two-thirds of] the congressional districts in the state, and petitions 4 5 proposing laws shall be signed by [five] ten percent of such 6 voters. Every such petition shall be filed with the secretary of state not less than six months before the 7 election and shall contain an enacting clause and the full 8 9 text of the measure. Petitions for constitutional amendments shall not contain more than one amended and 10

11 revised article of this constitution, or one new article 12 which shall not contain more than one subject and matters 13 properly connected therewith, and the enacting clause thereof shall be "Be it resolved by the people of the state 14 15 of Missouri that the Constitution be amended:". Petitions for laws shall contain not more than one subject which shall 16 be expressed clearly in the title, and the enacting clause 17 18 thereof shall be "Be it enacted by the people of the state 19 of Missouri:".

Section 51. The initiative shall not be used for the appropriation of money other than of new revenues created 2 3 and provided for thereby, or for any other purpose prohibited by this constitution. Except as provided in this 4 5 constitution, any measure proposed shall take effect when 6 approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon, provided 7 the total number of votes cast in support of the measure is 8 not less than thirty-five percent of the total number of ballots cast at the election. When conflicting measures are 9 10 approved at the same election the one receiving the largest affirmative vote shall prevail. 11
