Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 1023, Page 7, Section 182.802, Line 207,

2 by inserting after "cent" the following: ", or for any  
 3 county with more than one hundred thousand but fewer than  
 4 one hundred twenty thousand inhabitants and with a county  
 5 seat with more than nine thousand but fewer than eleven  
 6 thousand inhabitants or any county with more than fifty  
 7 thousand but fewer than sixty thousand inhabitants, not to  
 8 exceed one-third of one cent,"; and

9 Further amend said bill and section, page 8, line 221,  
 10 by inserting after "2." the following: "(1)"; and further  
 11 amend line 238, by inserting after all of said line the  
 12 following:

13 "(2) For any district located in a county with more  
 14 than one hundred thousand but fewer than one hundred twenty  
 15 thousand inhabitants and with a county seat with more than  
 16 nine thousand but fewer than eleven thousand inhabitants or  
 17 any county with more than fifty thousand but fewer than  
 18 sixty thousand inhabitants and with a county seat with more  
 19 than seventeen thousand but fewer than twenty-one thousand  
 20 inhabitants, any sales tax imposed pursuant to this section  
 21 shall be in conjunction with the elimination of all real and  
 22 personal property tax levies imposed by the district for  
 23 each year in which the sales tax is imposed. The ballot of  
 24 submission for such district shall contain, but need not be  
 25 limited to, the following language:

27 Shall the library district impose a district-  
28 wide sales tax of (insert amount) and eliminate its  
29 total real and personal property tax levy for the purpose of  
30 providing funding for library district?

33 If you are in favor of the question, place an "X" in  
34 the box opposite "YES". If you are opposed to the question,  
35 place an "X" in the box opposite "NO".

37 If a majority of the votes cast on the proposal by the  
38 qualified voters voting thereon are in favor of the  
39 proposal, then the ordinance or order and any amendments  
40 thereto shall be in effect. If a majority of the votes cast  
41 by the qualified voters voting are opposed to the proposal,  
42 then the board of directors shall have no power to impose  
43 the sales tax and eliminate the property tax as herein  
44 authorized unless and until the board of directors shall  
45 again have submitted another proposal to authorize board of  
46 directors to impose the sales tax and eliminate the property  
47 tax under the provisions of this section and such proposal  
48 is approved by a majority of the qualified voters voting  
49 thereon."
