#### FISCAL ANALYSIS

### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the Department of Public Safety (DPS) - Division of Fire Safety, DPS - Missouri Highway Patrol, Missouri Department of Conservation, Office of the Governor, Department of Natural Resources, Office of Lieutenant Governor, Eureka Fire Protection District, Springfield Police Department, Taney County Ambulance District and St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department assume the proposal will not fiscally impact their organizations.

Officials from the **Valle Ambulance District** state this proposal will result in minimal cost savings to their organization. The proposal will result in their having to prepare and send data to one less recipient, therefore, resulting in a savings of approximately \$55.

**Oversight** assumes, based on local government responses, that the proposal would have a minimal positive fiscal impact on local governments.

### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business
