**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Department of Corrections, the Office of Attorney General, and the State Public Defender** stated this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services** stated there would be no significant direct fiscal impact on county prosecutors.

Officials from the **Saint Louis, Springfield, St Joseph, Lee's Summit, and Sikeston School Districts** did not respond to our request for fiscal note response.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

Current law requires superintendents to convene hearings in order to determine whether certain students may be enrolled in the district. The hearings must occur within five working days of the request to register. This proposal changes the aforementioned provision so that districts must convene such hearings within fifteen working days of the request to register.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
