ASSUMPTION

Officials of the **Warren County Clerk's Office** stated, there is no difference in cost for the County, but it is easier to have all non-partisan elections held at the same time (first municipal election).

Oversight assumes to hold an election that is not tied to any other political subdivision's election would have more cost then to have that same election to be held at the same time as municipal elections. Oversight assumes election cost savings would be minimal. Based on the county's estimates fiscal impact will be shown as \$0.

This act provides that the election of the Warren County Emergency Services Board members is to take place during the first municipal election in a calendar year.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
