**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education** state this proposal will have no fiscal impact on their agencies or school districts.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

Current law requires district boards to convene a hearing in order to determine whether a pupil shall be granted a waiver of certain registration requirements. This proposal would allow districts to convene a committee of their board in order to rule on such residency waiver requests.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


