**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials with the **Department of Labor and Industrial Relations** and the **Office of Administration - Division of Budget and Planning** assume no fiscal impact to their agencies.

Officials with the **Division of Personnel** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact to the state since the proposal would not increase the number of employees that might participate in disaster relief services each year nor does it increase the number of hours that an employee can provide each year.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

DESCRIPTION

This act would allow state employees, certified by volunteer agencies with a disaster service commitment recognized by the state emergency management agency, to be granted leave with pay while acting as a disaster service volunteer.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
