FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Conservation** (MDC) assume that allowing hand fishing for catfish and carp during the months of June and July would have an unknown fiscal impact to MDC. In response to a similar proposal in a prior session, however, MDC assumed the provision would have no fiscal impact to MDC.

Oversight assumes that MDC could require a valid license for hand fishing, however, Oversight also assumes that only a minimal number of persons would choose this method of fishing. Therefore, Oversight has not included any fiscal impact to the Conservation Commission Fund.
