No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

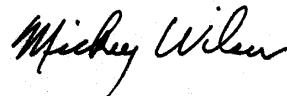
DESCRIPTION

This proposal modifies the law concerning the Joint Committee on Economic Development Policy and Planning. The proposal makes the chair and vice chair rotate between the House and the Senate on a biennial basis. Currently the rotation is annual. The proposal also specifies that the chair and vice chair are appointed by the leadership of the respective houses.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
