#### **DESCRIPTION**

This act modifies the information that must be provided to the Secretary of State when a group wishes to form a new political party. The act repeals the requirement that the petition to form the new party must contain, if presidential electors are to be nominated by petition, the name of at least one qualified resident in each congressional district to be a nominee for presidential elector.

The act also repeals the requirement that the petition must contain the names and addresses of the chairman and treasurer of the new party.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
