#### DESCRIPTION

This proposal permits a corporation to have some or all classes or series of its stock uncertificated. It also extends the appraisal remedy available for corporate mergers and acquisitions to situations where a corporation sells all or substantially all of its corporate assets. The proposal also modifies language regarding the filing of amendments or restatements of a corporations articles of incorporation with the secretary of state.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
