FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety** indicated there would be no fiscal impact to their agency as a result of this proposed legislation.

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE)** stated there would be no fiscal impact to their agency resulting from this proposal. DESE deferred to the St Louis Public School District regarding fiscal impact to their district.

Officials from the **Saint Louis Public School District** did not respond to our request for a fiscal note. **Oversight** assumes, based on a proposal from this session that addresses the subject of termination hearings (SB 118 - FN 443-01), that there could be fiscal impact to the Saint Louis Public School District for hearing expenses. **Oversight** assumes that hearing expenses for this one school district would not exceed \$100,000 per year.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal allows permanent employees of the metropolitan school district to be removed if the employee is convicted of a state or federal crime or if the employee is incompetent.

Further, the proposal alters the metropolitan school district's procedures with regard to the termination hearing process for employees subject to removal. The proposed legislation allows the board to appoint a hearing officer in order to hear such cases.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
