**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Department of Transportation, Department of Revenue, Department of Public Safety – Director’s Office, – Missouri State Highway Patrol, and the Department of Insurance** assume the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Attorney General** did not respond to Oversight’s request for fiscal impact. However, in response to a previous version of the proposal (HB 362, LR # 1070-01), officials assumed any potential costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed within existing resources.

Officials from the **Office of State Courts Administrator** assume the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the courts.

Officials from the **Office of Prosecution Services** assume the proposal would not have a significant direct fiscal impact on county prosecutors.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would specify that when records of an alcohol-related driving offense or an arrest record are ordered expunged by the court the records and files maintained in any administrative, associate circuit court, or circuit court proceeding are confidential and only available to the parties or by order of the court for good cause.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
