DESCRIPTION

This proposal requires applicants for licensure as a professional counselor, after August 28, 2007, to complete a minimum of three hours of graduate level coursework in diagnostic systems. All licensed professional counselors shall be required to pay a renewal fee and submit evidence of the completion of continuing education.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
