**FISCAL ANALYSIS**

**ASSUMPTION**

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This proposed legislation creates a lien against real estate for non-payment of rental equipment fees. The proposal includes a statute of limitations which begins to run upon the return of the equipment and expires six weeks from said date.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.


