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#### **DESCRIPTION**

This Senate Concurrent Resolution supports the implementation of the Comprehensive Cancer Action Plan to review data regarding cervical cancer and evaluating methods to provide women with information and screening of cervical cancer. The plan is to be implemented by the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and the Missouri Cancer Consortium. The plan will present yearly cancer control strategies to the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, President Pro Tem of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and post the information on the Missouri state Internet website.
