FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

If the City of Excelsior Springs would impose an increase in the levy for museum purposes small businesses would be expected to pay the increase.

DESCRIPTION

This act allows the City of Excelsior Springs to levy a tax at thirty cents on the one hundred dollars assessed for hospital, public health, or museum purposes in lieu of the twenty cents currently provided by statute.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
