FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Elementary and Secondary Education**, **Office of the Governor**, **Missouri Senate**, and the **House of Representatives** indicated this proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective agencies.

Officials from the **Office of the Secretary of State (SOS)** assume statewide newspaper publication of state statutes cost approximately \$1,289 per column inch based on an estimate provided by the Missouri Press Service. Three printings are required by the Constitution and state statute; therefore publication cost would total \$3,867 per column inch. SOS estimates the total number of column inches for this amendment to be 5 inches including title header and certification paragraph. ($$3,867 \times 10 = $19,335$). Costs are based on 2004 figures and are subject to change.

Oversight assumes that the election would be held at the regularly scheduled general election and assumes no local fiscal impact.

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General** did not respond to a request for fiscal note.

FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

This proposed constitutional amendment states that the power to determine public school funding shall exclusively be the province of the General Assembly and the Governor. The power to determine public school funding shall not fall within the province of the judiciary.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
