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#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

### **DESCRIPTION**

This proposal would authorize the Governor to convey land to Manchester United Methodist Church in exchange for another parcel of land. The Manchester United Methodist Church would construct a new group home to specifications and design approved by the Commissioner of Administration on property owned by the church, and convey the group home and property to the state. The Commissioner of Administration would set the terms and conditions of the sale, and the Attorney General would approve as to form the instrument of conveyance.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
