No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


DESCRIPTION

The act provides that the Sunshine Law shall only apply to certain non-profit organizations to the extent that a vote, record or meeting pertains to a contract with a public governmental body or to an activity carried out under an agreement with a public governmental body.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
