FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

This proposal prohibits a person who represents a company that has been fined in any state for promoting prostitution or providing prostitutes for customer entertainment within twenty years prior to filing an application with the gaming commission from receiving a license to conduct gambling games or operate an excursion gambling boat.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
