#### FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

### **DESCRIPTION**

Under this act, no person would be elected to serve more than eight years total as the County Executive or in the Legislature of Jackson County. In applying this section, service resulting from an election prior to this act becoming effective, or service of less than two years, in the case of a member elected after the effective date of this section to complete the term of another person shall not be counted.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
