FISCAL IMPACT - Small Business

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation would remove the Corrections Officer Certification Commission's ability to:

- 1. Cause a job task analysis to be made of jobs of jailers and private jail custody staff;
- 2. Make recommendations to the Department of Corrections, the legislature, or the Governor concerning the qualifications, training, testing, and certification of such individuals; or
- 3. Recommend qualifications and training standards for such individuals.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
