ASSUMPTION

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.

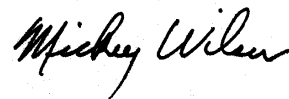
DESCRIPTION

This proposal provides that if an insurance company pays a claim on a salvage vehicle and the insured is retaining ownership of the vehicle, as prior salvage, the vehicle will not be subject to the examination conducted by the Highway Patrol in order for a title to be obtained.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
