This proposed legislation requires any school district that levies an operating levy for school purposes that is less than the performance levy, as such term is defined in Section 163.011, must written notice to the Department of Elementary & Secondary Education asserting whether or not such district is providing an adequate education to the students of the district. If a district asserts that it is not providing an adequate education, such inadequacy shall be deemed to be a result of insufficient local effort.

The provisions of this proposed legislation shall not apply to any Special School District.

This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
